WHAT YOU MUST PAY...

Senior Dues

Every senior MUST pay \$75 Senior Dues by 10/12/22 in order to attend Senior Day. In January the price increases to \$80.

You can bring cash or check (made out to Glenn High School) to Mrs. Carmichael in room 607. You can pay online by going to the Glenn High School website, choosing Families/Community, then Online School Payments, then Glenn High from the High School drop down bar, and then select Senior Dues. Paying this way has a small fee. Senior Dues cover the costs associated with all senior events throughout the year including: two t-shirts, class gift (to GHS), gifts to the class throughout the year, senior trips, transportation, food, security and other expenses. It also covers all graduation costs such as the stage, chairs, decorations, flowers, audio/video, security, and more.

Cap and Gown

You must buy your cap, tassel, gown and stole from Jostens for around \$43. They will give out information at our 2nd senior class meeting on 9/21/22. You can pay with cash, check or card in person at Senior Day on 10/12/22 or you can order online with card after that. This includes a cap, tassel, gown and stole. You can choose to buy other graduation items from Jostens as well.

YOU MAY ALSO CHOOSE TO BUY...

Senior Pictures

There are several pictures you may choose to purchase from Lifetouch including:

- Yearbook Picture (wear provided suit or black drape)
- Cap & Gown Picture (wear provided cap, tassel, gown & stole)
- Class of 2023 Stadium Picture (all students in the stadium)
- Graduation Pictures (photos of you at graduation on stage)

Senior Apparel

You can choose to buy Senior Class of 2023 t-shirts, sweatshirts, sweatpants and more. There will be times during the year when we sell certain items and designs. You can pay cash to Mrs. Parnell in room 616.

Senior Trip

We plan to go to Carowinds on 5/19/22. This trip usually costs around \$60 and lasts all day. We will have more details as we get closer to the event.

GRADUATION INFO

We graduate on our campus in the stadium. Each student will receive 10 tickets for guests to attend graduation. If a student needs more than 10 tickets please let Mrs. Carmichael or Mrs. Parnell know. Each student will receive two parking permits to park on campus. Families may need to drop off, carpool or park off campus. We have shuttles for parking off campus. The stadium will open two hours before the ceremony and seating is first come. All guests must have a clear bag. Large items like balloons, umbrellas, etc. will not be allowed in the stadium. Concessions will be sold before the ceremony.

Students must arrive at the 400 building two hours before the ceremony, properly dressed with their cap, tassel, gown and stole. The male dress code is a white collared button up dress shirt with a tie/bow tie, dress pants (black, navy, brown, tan- no jeans) and dress shoes (black, navy, brown, tan). The female dress code is a dress that does not show below the gown and dress shoes (white, clear, black, navy, brown, tan). No student may wear athletic shoes, flip flops, sandals, slides, slippers, etc. We have extra clothing and shoes if a student needs it.

Students may choose to decorate their cap, as long as it is school appropriate and the design is flat (not 3-D).

All students MUST attend graduation practice to participate in the graduation ceremony!
